Isoprenoid Conference main themes: Synthesis and isolation; Biosynthesis; Bioactivity; Environmental and Medical Issues; Research methodologies; Industrial and practical applications



The famous Conference on Isoprenoids was originally established as a Polish-Czechoslovak forum for natural products chemists by Professors Marian Kocór, Václav Černý, Vlastimil Herout, Jozef Tomko, and their colleagues. The conference played an important role in improving contacts among European chemists.

The "Isoprenoids" forum quickly became known as a pioneering channel in the 1960s and 1970s that overcame the very high Arrhenius barrier - the "Iron Curtain" - which restricted contacts between chemists on either side. Later, the conference evolved into a forum that brought together as many "isoprenoid folks" as possible from various fields of research to promote the practical applications of isoprenoid science and disseminate information.
